

# WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** To prevent electrocution, make sure the cord is not connected to a power source before installing the wiring device.  
Failure to comply with the following instructions could cause an electrical failure or fire.

## SALT WATER IMMERSION

DISCONNECT FROM POWER SOURCE. RINSE PLUG/CONNECTOR THOROUGHLY IN FRESH WATER, SHAKE OR BLOW OUT EXCESS WATER, AND ALLOW TO DRY. SPRAY WITH MOISTURE DISPLACEMENT BEFORE RE-USE.

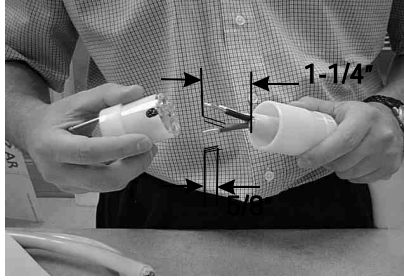
Use in wet condition we strongly recommend use of weatherproof covers (102N, 103RN, or 103ELN).

**Note:** Use round-jacketed cable with diameter from .300 in. (18/3 SJ) through .720 in. (10/3 S).

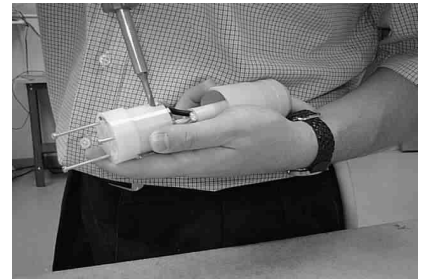
Note: Be sure to put boot (wiring device cover) on cord before wiring.



**1** Back out the three recessed screws and separate sections.



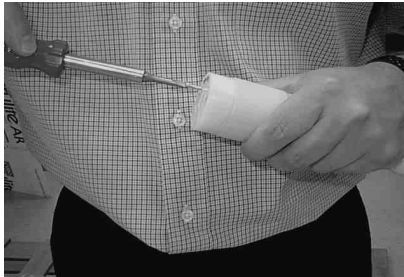
**2** Slide housing over cord. Strip 5/8 in. of insulation off each of the three wires. Make sure the wire is clean and a bright copper color. Do not solder the ends of the wire.



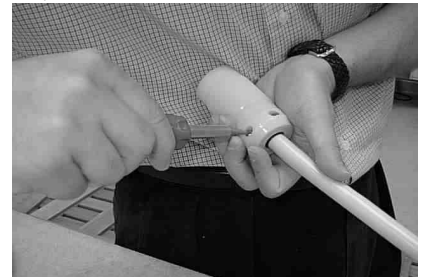
**3** Insert bare wires into their corresponding color-coded terminals. Make certain there is not wire insulation under any terminal clamp. Tighten the screw clamps to 14-20 inch-pounds torque.



**4** Recouple the two sections by aligning the key with the key slot.



**5** Tighten down the recessed screws with moderate torque.



**6** Tighten cord clamp by tighten two assembly screws to 16-20 inch-pounds torque.
