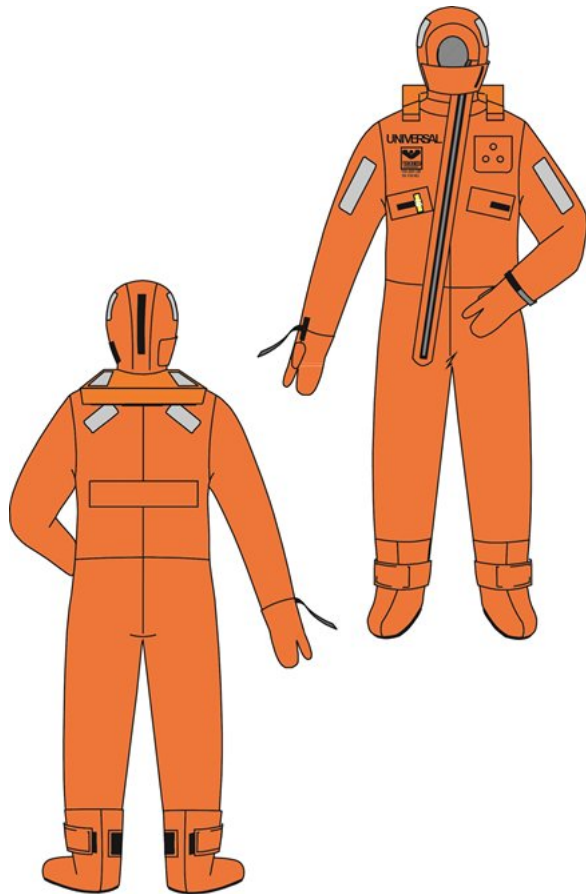

## PS2006 VIKING Immersion suit, Neoprene, with buoyancy head support USCG



PS2006 is a USCG approved neoprene immersion suit with built-in buoyancy head support. The built-in buoyancy gives excellent freeboard and ensures that the suit can be used without a lifejacket. This is a big advantage in situations of emergency where there might not be time to put on a life jacket. The suit is built from high flexible, high quality neoprene to ensure easy donning and fit. This also gives the product a longer lifespan. The suit has an extended zipper which gives the suit a better in-water performance and ensures quick donning. The extended zipper also provides more comfort for the user and minimizes water ingress. All suits are produced in-house according to stringent manufacturing requirements.
